
1-Piece Shower

with solid core, reinforced bottom



- 1 Check shower pocket area for level and for correct dimensions. Make sure drain hole in floor is in the correct position.
- 2 DRY-FIT THE SHOWER: Set shower unit in the pocket. You MUST use a level to ensure unit is level. Shim if necessary.



- 3 Remove shower unit from the framing pocket. Have a plumber install drain fitting in shower bottom (see Steps 7–9). Plumber should also prepare drain pipe to receive the drain.
 - To avoid deforming the shower bottom, once drain fitting is installed DO NOT store the unit resting on the drain.
- 4 Sweep the floor and remove all debris from pocket area, then position shower in pocket.
- Make sure floor drains properly by pouring water on it or checking it with a level. If in doubt, remove shower and review the previous steps.
- 6 Screw flanges to framing at 12" maximum on-center vertically and horizontally at each stud.



- Slide inside compression gasket into drain body and slip over pipe.

 Make sure beveled end of inside compression gasket is facing up and is flush with pipe surface.
- Tighten inside compression nut into drain body using the tool provided.
